Gage Road, Sprowston – Footpath Maintenance

Starting on 22 January 2024, Norfolk County Council will be closing Gage Road in Sprowston to carry out essential footpath maintenance works. The works are expected to last 7 weeks, weather permitting.

During the works, access to properties and businesses will be maintained at all times where possible.

The works are due to take place throughout Gage Road from the junction with Linacre Avenue and Parana Road. To complete the works as efficiently as possible a road closure is required to minimise traffic passing through Gage Road. During the works we require a compound site and the only suitable place for this is in the junction bell mouth between Gage Road and Linacre Avenue. This will mean the entrance to Gage Road will be blocked from Linacre Avenue. A fully signed diversion route will be in place.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while the footpath maintenance work is carried out and we apologise for any disturbance caused by the works.

The work which will cost around £75,000 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
