HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 PART 8A SECTIONS 129A-129G NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (DOLMAN SQUARE, COBHOLM, GREAT YARMOUTH) GATING ORDER 2007

This Order is made by Norfolk County Council ("the Council") under Sections 129A-129G of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") and all other enabling powers because

(a) the highway described in Article 1 below is a relevant highway ("the highway")

(b) the Council is the highway authority for the highway

(c) the Council is satisfied that the conditions in section 129A(3) of the 1980 Act have been met.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. Except as provided in Article 2 below the use by the public of the highway set out in Schedule 1 shall be restricted at all times
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 above shall apply to:
 - (a) owners or occupiers of premises adjacent to or adjoining the highway affected by the Order; or
 - (b) to persons using the highway:
 - (i) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes
 - (ii) in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - (iii) in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of highway or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of highway of any sewer, water, gas or electricity apparatus or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984
 - (iv) for the provision of a universal postal service as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000
 - (v) with the permission or at the direction of a duly authorised officer of the Council
- 3. The Council authorises the installation operation and maintenance of key operated barriers at the north-west and south-east end of the highway

- Anyone wishing to contact the Council officer responsible for maintaining and operating the barrier used to enforce this Order should contact the Highway Manager on 0844 8008009 Monday to Friday between 08.00hrs and 18.00hrs.
- 5. The alternative route is set out in Schedule 2
- 6. The Order will take effect on the date it is made but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity on the grounds that the Council had no power to make it or that any requirement under Part 8A of the Highways Act 1980 was not complied with in relation to the Order he may under section 129D of the Act within six weeks beginning on the date on which the Order is made make an application for that purpose to the High Court.
