I, Dr David Ormerod of Mill House, 7 Mill Lane, Swaffham, Norfolk PE37 7EU hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 to modify the definitive map and statement for the County of Norfolk by re-establishing the historical Coburg Lane (comprising Coburg Lane in Saham Toney and Ashill FP7) 'as a restricted byway.

THE SEGMENT A TO B IS CURRENTLY AN UNREGISTERED PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY, COMPRISING THE SAHAM TONEY COMPONENT OF (OLD) COBURG LANE. THE PRESENT CONFIGURATION OF THE APPLICATION ROUTE IS ON ITS HISTORICAL ROADBED EXCEPT FOR THE SEGMENT C-D-E. THE ORIGINAL ROUTE WAS C-E, AND WAS CHANGED DURING A MODIFICATION OF THE FIELD STRUCTURE WITHIN THE LAST 40 YEARS. THE SPAN B-G IS CURRENTLY ASHILL FP 7.
