I, Dr David Ormerod of Mill House, 7 Mill Lane, Swaffham, Norfolk PE37 7EU hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 to modify the definitive map and statement for the County of Norfolk by adding Harpers Lane, Horningroft parish, and the old Brisley Heath Road, Brisley parish as Restricted Byways.

It is likely that the former Brisley Heath Road went straight on at this juncture to meet the Brisley-North Elmham parish boundary. This can also be reached by a short north deviation along the farm track, but the old maps do not illustrate such a chicane-like deviation
- Photograph (May 2020) looking to the west along the former roadbed of the Brisley Heath Road, that was probably on the southern side of the hedgerow, now occupied by a drainage ditch. This is taken from neat Point D.
- Photograph (May 2020) from Point E on Gateley Road, Brisley, looking to the NW along the former roadbed along the exit section of Brisley Heath Road along the Brisley-North Elmham parish boundary.
