I, Ian Michael Witham of The Hollies, Church Lane, Edingthorpe, Norfolk NR28 9TJ hereby apply for an order under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:

adding the restricted byway from Church Road, Bradfield (in the civil parish of Swafield), at the grid reference TG 2595 3339 to the grid reference TG 2604 3384 where it turns to follow a west-north-westerly course to cross the parish boundary into Antingham parish.

and upgrading to a restricted byway the footpath from the aforementioned point, to the Antingham/Southrepps Road, described, in the definitive statement, as being "opposite smithy", and at the grid reference TG 2581 3389, in the parish of Antingham

and adding the restricted byway from the grid reference TG 2604 3384 to the grid reference of TG 2607 3406 (approx) in the parish of Swafield

and adding to the particulars of the said ways by providing that the width is that shown excluded from the hereditaments on the Finance Act 1910 Valuation Plan and that there are no limitations or conditions on the use of the route by the public

and shown on the map accompanying this application.


