5. Non-technical description of the Proposed Development ?

* Brief non-technical description of the Proposed Development

The Great Yarmouth River Crossing Scheme involves the construction, operation and maintenance of a new crossing of the River Yare in Great Yarmouth, consisting of a new dual carriageway road, including a road bridge across the river, linking the A47 at Harfrey's Roundabout on the western side of the river to the A1243 South Denes Road on the eastern side. The Scheme would feature an opening span double leaf bascule (lifting) bridge across the river, involving the construction of two new 'knuckles' extending the quay wall into the river to support the bridge. The Scheme would include a bridge span over the existing Southtown Road on the western side of the river, and a bridge span on the eastern side of the river to provide an underpass for existing businesses, enabling the new dual carriageway road to rise westwards towards the crest of the new crossing.
