Norwich: Barrack Street – Toucan Crossing Traffic Light Replacement starting February 2024

The replacement of the traffic lights at the Toucan crossing on Barrack Street adjacent to the Nuffield Health Norwich Fitness & Wellbeing Gym is due to start on Monday 19 February. The work is expected to take 5 days to complete, weather permitting.

This is part of a countywide traffic signal replacement programme which involves updating traffic lights where necessary to ensure they continue to meet current standards and work reliably and efficiently.

A temporary crossing will be in place while the existing signals are off for replacement. The work will involve the removal and replacement of the traffic lights with new equipment, and also work under the road to fit new underground ducting and cabling.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this traffic light replacement work is carried out.

The work which will cost £23,000 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
