Martineau Lane/ A146 Barrett Road & Loddon Road (Trowse Bypass) – Overnight closures for highway maintenance works

Norfolk County Council is set to carry out essential road re-surfacing and bridge repair works at the Martineau Lane and A146 Trowse bypass junction. The current programme has works starting on Monday 4 March 2024 and finishing on or before Friday 15 March 2024, subject to any weather or construction delays.

To minimise disruption at this very busy junction, which is one of the main strategic routes in and out of Norwich - we are planning on carrying out the works at night, under a road closure between the hours of 8pm – 6am Monday to Friday. This will allow the workforce to carry out the works as safely and efficiently as possible, whilst also avoiding peak traffic hours. The road will be open as usual at all other times.

The extent of the road closure on the A146 Barrett Road and Martineau Lane will be between the junction with Long John Hill, to the County Hall roundabout. A night-time road closure on the A146 Loddon Road (Trowse Bypass) will also be in operation between the junction of Martineau Lane to just west of the A47 Interchange. Access to businesses and properties within the closure will be maintained, however, there is chance of minor delays whilst the surfacing works take place outside properties. Fully signed official diversion routes will be in place for the duration of the works.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this essential road and bridge maintenance work is carried out.

The work which will cost £300,000 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
