I, Dr David Ormerod of Mill House, 7 Mill Lane, Swaffham, Norfolk PE37 7EU hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by registering an old public carriage road that up till approximately 1830 was part of the historical Icknield Way between Flitcham Parish Church and the old Vicarage (now Hironnelle House). It was bypassed. No highway modification orders have been found. There is evidence that the public rights of way persist. Land Registry INSPIRE data georeferenced mapping shows that the southern part of the old roadbed is still owned by the County Highway authority, with the remainder 'over-registered' in the 20th century. In the absence of an extinguishment order, the most appropriate designation on the Definitive Map is as a restricted byway. The green lane highway is obstructed at the NW corner of Hironnelle House by the end of a hedgerow with the old gate therein.

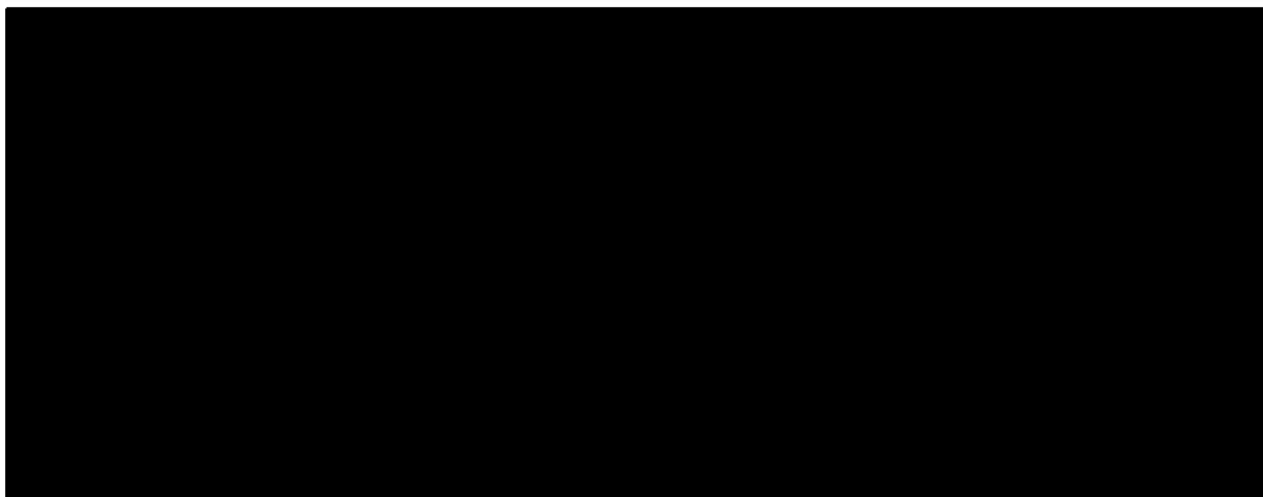


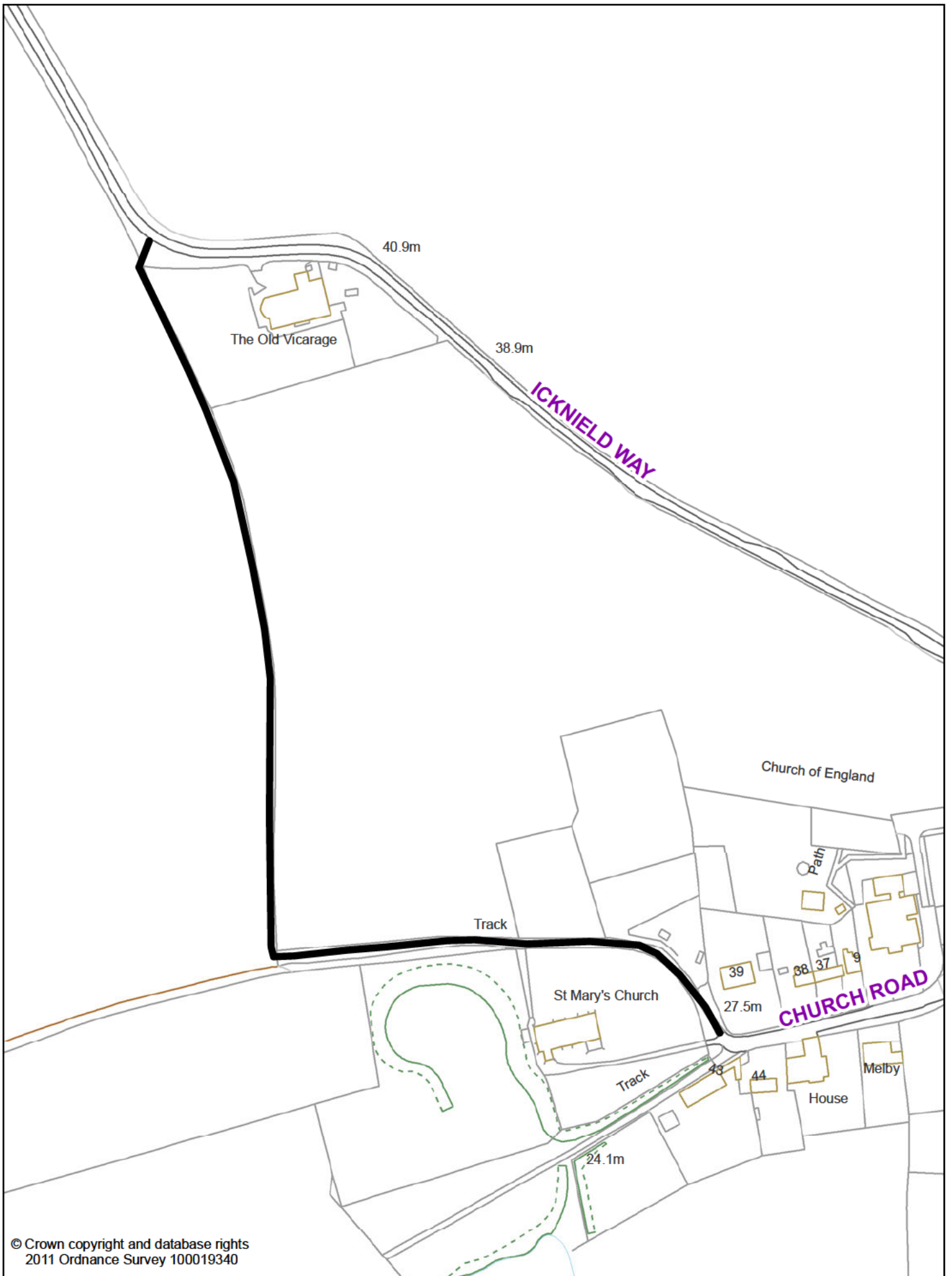
