adding the footpath from Sale Court, Loddon to Bridge Street/Church Plain Loddon

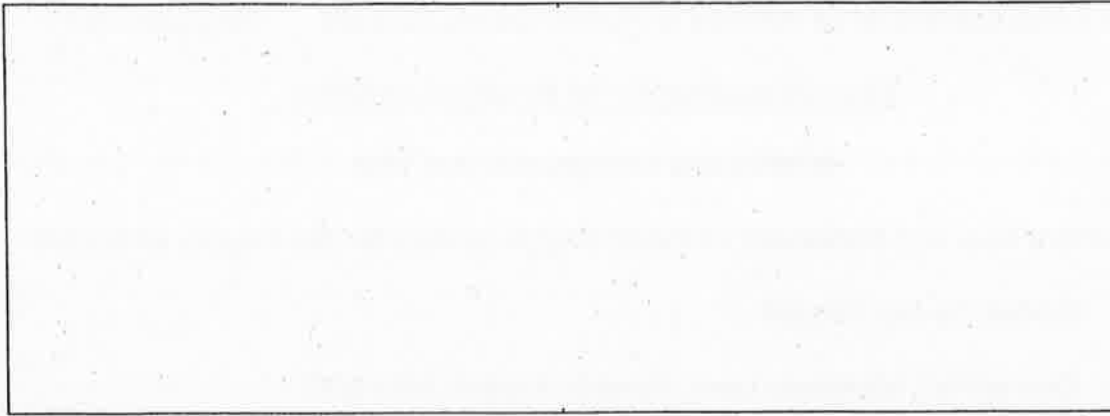
