## New Mills Yard Bridge TG20117 Closed Until 2025

From 15 April 2024, New Mills Yard Bridge TG20117 will be closed to pedestrians and cyclists for safety reasons due to structural deterioration which may have reduced the load-bearing capability of the structure.

The bridge located at New Mills Yard, Norwich, NR3 3AX will be permanently closed until renewal of the bridge. During this time two suitable pedestrian diversion routes shall be in place for convenience. These routes can be seen on the Closure Diversion Plan.

A scheme to replace this bridge is currently being developed. Subject to Planning Permissions and approval, this work is expected to begin in 2025.

The scheme will be designed to ensure the new bridge improves upon the current appearance of the existing bridge, whilst maintaining the historic character and Heritage of the area.


The County Council thanks people for their patience and understanding while this necessary bridge closure is in place.
