TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC MOVEMENT

Norfolk County Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the St George's Day Parade, they intend to make a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic on the following roads using a rolling road closure.

- A149 Runton Road from its junction with U10212 Alfred Road, heading east for 315m until its junction with A149 Prince of Wales Road.
- A149 Prince of Wales Road from its junction with A149 Runton Road, heading south for 130m until its junction with A149 Hamilton Road.
- A149 Hamilton Road from its junction with A149 Prince of Wales Road, heading east for 80m until its junction with A149 Church Street.
- A149 Church Street from its junction with A149 Hamilton Road, heading east for 240m until its junction with U10222 Brooke Street.
- U10222 Brooke Street from its junction with A149 Church Street, heading North for 80m until its junction with U10221 Tucker Street.
- U10221 Tucker Street from its junction with U10222 Brooke Street, heading west for 120m until its junction with U10221 Tucker Street.
- U10219 High Street from its junction with U10221 Tucker Street, heading south for 25m.
- No parking U10219 High Street, from its junction with U10221 Tucker Street, heading south for 25m in the PARISH OF Cromer.

The Order will come into effect on Saturday 27 April 2024 and will remain in force for 45 minutes. The road will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access) on Saturday 27 April 2024 between 10:30 hrs and 11:15 hrs. Restrictions on traffic will only be enforced until normal traffic flow can be maintained.

Where appropriate during the period of the closure temporary suspension of existing permanent Traffic Orders may be imposed.
