A149/B1105 Junction & A149 Burnt Street, Wells-next-the-Sea Carriageway Maintenance Works

Norfolk County Council is set to carry out essential road re-surfacing works at the A149 Two Furlong Hill and Burnt Street junction, and also surface dressing works on A149 Burnt Street and Church Street. The re-surfacing works at the junction is expected to last 2 days and the surface dressing works along Burnt Street and Church Street is expected to last 2 days, subject to any weather conditions or construction delays.

The works will be completed under a road closure which will enable us to carry out the works as safely and efficiently as possible. The A149 Two Furlong Hill and Burnt Street junction will be closed 22 April and 23 April 2024. Burnt Street and Church Street will be closed on 24 April and 25 April 2024 (B1105 Fakenham Road and A149 Two Furlong Hill will be open as usual for this part of the works).

Access to businesses and properties within the closure will be maintained, however, there is chance of minor delays whilst the surfacing works take place outside. Fully signed official diversion routes will be in place for the duration of the works.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this maintenance work is carried out.

The work, which will cost £47,000, will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.




Figure 1. Extent of carriageway resurfacing works. Blue shows junction resurfacing
