TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC MOVEMENT

Norfolk County Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the Birmingham Diocesan Pilgrimage, they intend to make a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic on the U14091 Station Road, from junction of U19946 Egmere Link Road, heading east for 215m. C586 High Street from its junction with U14091 Friday Market Place, heading North for 195m. C597 Common Place, from its junction with C586 High Street, heading east for 175m. In the PARISH OF Walsingham.

The Order will come into effect on Saturday 11 May 2024 and will remain in force for 1 hour and 45 minutes. The road will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access) on Saturday 11 May 2024 between 15:30hrs and 17:15hrs. Restrictions on traffic will only be enforced until normal traffic flow can be maintained.

Where appropriate during the period of the closure temporary suspension of existing permanent Traffic Orders may be imposed.

Alternative route will be via: Church Street, Sunk Road, Holt Road, Knight Street and Egmere Road.
