Road closure on A148 Fakenham Road for Surface Dressing works

Work is due to start on Monday 29 April 2024 to surface dress a section of the A148 Fakenham Road. To allow the work to be carried out safely and swiftly it will be necessary to close the road to through traffic on a number of dates when the surfacing is underway, line painting is being carried out, and cat's eyes (road studs) are being renewed. Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

The work, which is weather dependant, will be carried out in phases with any road closures only in place for a number of hours at a time on the following dates:

29 April 2024 (2-day allowance for unsuitable weather) - Road stud removal evening / overnight works 19:00 – 06:00.

Surface dressing to be completed under convoy (No road closure required).

30 May 2024 (2-day allowance for unsuitable weather) - Road marking and road stud replacement evening / overnight works 19:00-6:00.

A fully signed diversion route will be in operation for the duration of the works. The County Council thanks people for their patience while this essential road maintenance work is carried out.

The work which will cost £11.785m over 280 miles of Norfolk's road network will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors Tarmac.
