Tree maintenance works – Chequers Lane, Gissing

Essential tree maintenance is planned to be carried out on Chequers Lane, Gissing 76107 from 24 April 2024 to 26 April 2024. The work will be carried out between 9am to 3pm, and is expected to take 3 days to complete, weather permitting.

Due to the nature of the work the road will need to be closed from 76107 Chequers Lane with the junction of Gissing FP9 and 76107 Upper Street to Broomfield House. No access to through traffic between these junctions will be available during the time the works are being carried out.

The work is necessary as the trees have been confirmed by the arboricultural team as diseased and dying and posing a risk to highway users, so unfortunately will need to be removed to ensure the highway can continue to be used safely. The hedge, undergrowth and other trees close by will be unaffected.

Detailed surveys will be carried out to ensure nesting birds are not disturbed. The work will be carried out at a later date if necessary.

There will be a fully signed diversion route in place while the work is underway.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this essential tree maintenance work is carried out.
