## PMB844 - Cliff Terrace, Hunstanton - Pavement Resurfacing

Essential pavement resurfacing works on Cliff Terrace, Hunstanton are planned to take place from 1 May 2024 and are expected to take 7 weeks to complete, weather permitting. The work will see the existing damaged pavement surface removed and replaced with a new asphalt surface.

To allow the pavement resurfacing to be carried out safely, Cliff Terrace, from the junction of Northgate to the junction of Cliff Parade, will be restricted to a one-way system to allow access for the duration of the works. The one-way system will allow vehicles to access Cliff Terrace from East to West. Access to properties, for both pedestrians and vehicles, will be maintained; however, there may be some short delays to vehicular access. Parking along Cliff Terrace will be suspended for the duration of the works to allow for a secure site compound to be installed on the carriageway and allow the contactor safe working widths whilst the scheme is constructed.

Business open as usual signs will be clearly displayed, a fully signed diversion route will be in place for the duration of the works, and emergency services and bus companies will also be made aware of the closure.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this essential pavement resurfacing work is carried out.

The work which will cost £80,000 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
