## TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC MOVEMENT

Norfolk County Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the Downham Market Festival, they intend to make a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic on the C885 Railway Road (from the junction of the A1122 Downham Market Bypass eastwards to the junction C885 Bridge Street); C885 Bridge Street (from the junction of C885 Railway Road eastwards to the junction C885 High Street); C885 High Street (from the junction of C885 Bridge Street north-eastwards to the junction of C884 Church Road); C884 Church Road (from the junction C885 High Street southwards to the junction of the C492 Howdale Road); C492 Howdale Road (from the junction C884 Church Road eastwards to the eastern end of the Howdale recreation ground 220 metres eastwards) in the PARISH OF DOWNHAM MARKET.

The Order will come into effect on Monday 27 May 2024 and will remain in force for a maximum period of 15 minutes at any point. The road will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access) on Monday 27 May 2024 between 12:00hrs and 16:00hrs. Restrictions on traffic will only be enforced until normal traffic flow can be maintained.

Where appropriate during the period of the closure, temporary suspension of existing permanent Traffic Orders may be imposed

Alternative route will be via: A1122 Western Bypass; A1122 Downham Market Bypass; A10 Downham Market Bypass; C885 Bexwell Road and vice versa.
