A10 Ferry Bank Junction, Southery - Essential Road Resurfacing

Work will begin on Tuesday 7 May 2024 to resurface a section of the A10 at the Ferry Bank Junction, on the Southery Bypass. The work will take place from the Lynn Road junction approximately 400 metres North. The works will see the damaged and worn-out road surface removed and replaced, and are expected to take 3 nights to complete, subject to suitable weather conditions.

Due to the nature of the work a full night-time road closure will be in place, between the hours of 7.00pm to 6.00am each day, to ensure the safety of site staff and public during the works and minimise disruption. The road will remain open during the day under traffic light control.

A fully signed official diversion route for vehicles (excluding southbound HGV's) will be in place via B1106(N), A134, A1122, A10(S).

Southbound HGVs to follow separate diversion route via A10(N), A1122 Downham Road, Wisbech Road, A47, A141, A142, A10. Bus routes will not be affected. Vehicle and pedestrian access to properties within the closure will be maintained however there may be short delays at times due to the nature of the works.

The work which will cost approximately £150,000 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this surface improvement work is carried out.
