Road Closed Monday 13 to Friday 17 May 2024 at Coltishall Bridge, B1150 Norwich Road.

I am writing to inform you about planned maintenance on the (TG21202) Coltishall Footbridge. The existing plywood deck has reached the end of its lifespan, and we will be replacing it with a new, more durable deck. To carry out the work safely the footbridge will be closed along with the main road bridge.

During the redecking process, the main road through Coltishall, B1150 Norwich Road/ High Street will be closed to vehicles for a week, Monday 13 May to Friday 17 May 2024. Pedestrians and cyclists will be rerouted over the main road bridge.

The road vehicular diversion will be via

- B1150 (Norwich Road, North Walsham Road),
- A1270 Broadland Northway (NDR),
- A140 (Cromer Road, Aylsham Bypass),
- B1145 (Banningham Road, North Walsham Road, Aylsham Road, North Walsham Road, Aylsham Road), Aylsham Road, Station Road, Millfield Road,
- B1150 (Norwich Road, North Walsham Road, Church Street, North Walsham Road, Station Road, High Street, Church Street).

Promoted diversion routes must use the same class of road or higher (A and B roads). This is so the larger numbers of traffic and bigger HGVs etc use the roads that are more suitable and that can take the increase and weight of traffic.

The work which will cost £20,000 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors Tarmac.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while these maintenance repairs to the bridge are carried out. We apologise for any disruption this may cause and appreciate your understanding.
