Hethersett Back Lane – Zebra Crossing

Works to install a brand-new crossing, underground electrical connections for the beacons, raised section in the road for the crossing, widening and resurfacing of the pavements, gully install/repositioning, resurfacing of the road, new road markings, and repositioning streetlights is currently programmed to start on or soon after for 28th May 2024 for approximately 9 weeks weather permitting.

To ensure that works can be completed safely, U78048 Back Lane will need to be closed to vehicular through traffic for the duration of the scheme. There will be a fully signed diversion route in place to direct traffic around the closure.

Access will be maintained throughout for residents although there may be some unavoidable delays during this time for which the County Council apologises. Access through the temporary closure for emergency vehicles will be managed by the site operatives.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this improvement work is carried out.

The work which will cost £97,000 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
