## **Caston, The Street – Carriageway Drainage Works and Temporary Road Closure**

The Street at Caston will be temporarily closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with Northacre and Stow Bedon Road from 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2023 for up to 16 weeks to carry out essential works to improve the carriageway drainage. The work will include the construction of a new drainage system along The Street to address the historic flooding issue around its junction with Duke's Lane.

Access for residents will be maintained during the works with signed diversion routes in place, although there may be some unavoidable temporary restrictions to frontages as the works progress however these will be agreed in advance by the operatives on site. Bus services inclusive of school services will also be diverted around the temporary closure as necessary and pedestrian access through the closure will be also be maintained.

Surveys of the historic drainage system found it beyond serviceable repair and therefore these works have been promoted by the County Council's Maintenance Team and have been co-ordinated with assistance from local landowners to achieve a solution to the drainage issue highlighted by the Local Member and Parish Council.

The temporary road closure will accommodate all residential traffic within the works extent, including access from Duke's Lane.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this drainage improvement work is carried out.

The work which will cost £142,000 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
