TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC MOVEMENT

Norfolk County Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the Alex Moore Relay, they intend to make a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic on the C275 Long Road, from its junction with C273 Church Road, to its junction with U19219 Black Horse Road.
