Hall Road Footbridge - Lakenham Way, Norwich

From Monday 3 June to Friday 7 June 2024, Hall Road Footbridge will be closed along with Lakenham Way (cycleway) directly underneath the footbridge.

The footbridge closure is required so the old plywood deck can be replaced. Hall Road itself will remain open.

Bicycles and pedestrians will be diverted onto the road bridge via the current controlled and uncontrolled crossing points. For safety concerns, Lakenham Way (cycle path) will be shut just beneath the footbridge - only during the day. Both pedestrians and cyclists will use the signed ramps to get on and off Lakenham Way.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while these repairs to the bridge are carried out.

The work which will cost £38,000 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors Tarmac.
